



ACVP EXAM PROCTOR DATA FORM

The following information is requested by the Council of the American College of Veterinary Pathologists to develop a database of ACVP diplomates interested in serving as proctors for the certifying examinations. Proctors are generally selected for the examination committee in late May or early June and will be required to register and attend (at their expense) the ACVP Annual Meeting later that year where there will be an orientation session in preparation for the coming year. Proctors are appointed to the ACVP Exam Committee for one year, during which they participate in the preparation and administration of the exam. The time commitment from January through September is substantial and attendance at two (an extended weekend meeting in early June, in Fort Collins, Colo., and a Monday through Friday meeting in Ames, Iowa, at the time of the examination in September) is required. Travel expenses during the year of service are covered by the ACVP. New examination committee members are usually selected from the pool of diplomates who have previously served as proctors.
